‘One, two, three, four...’ then he added his ears,

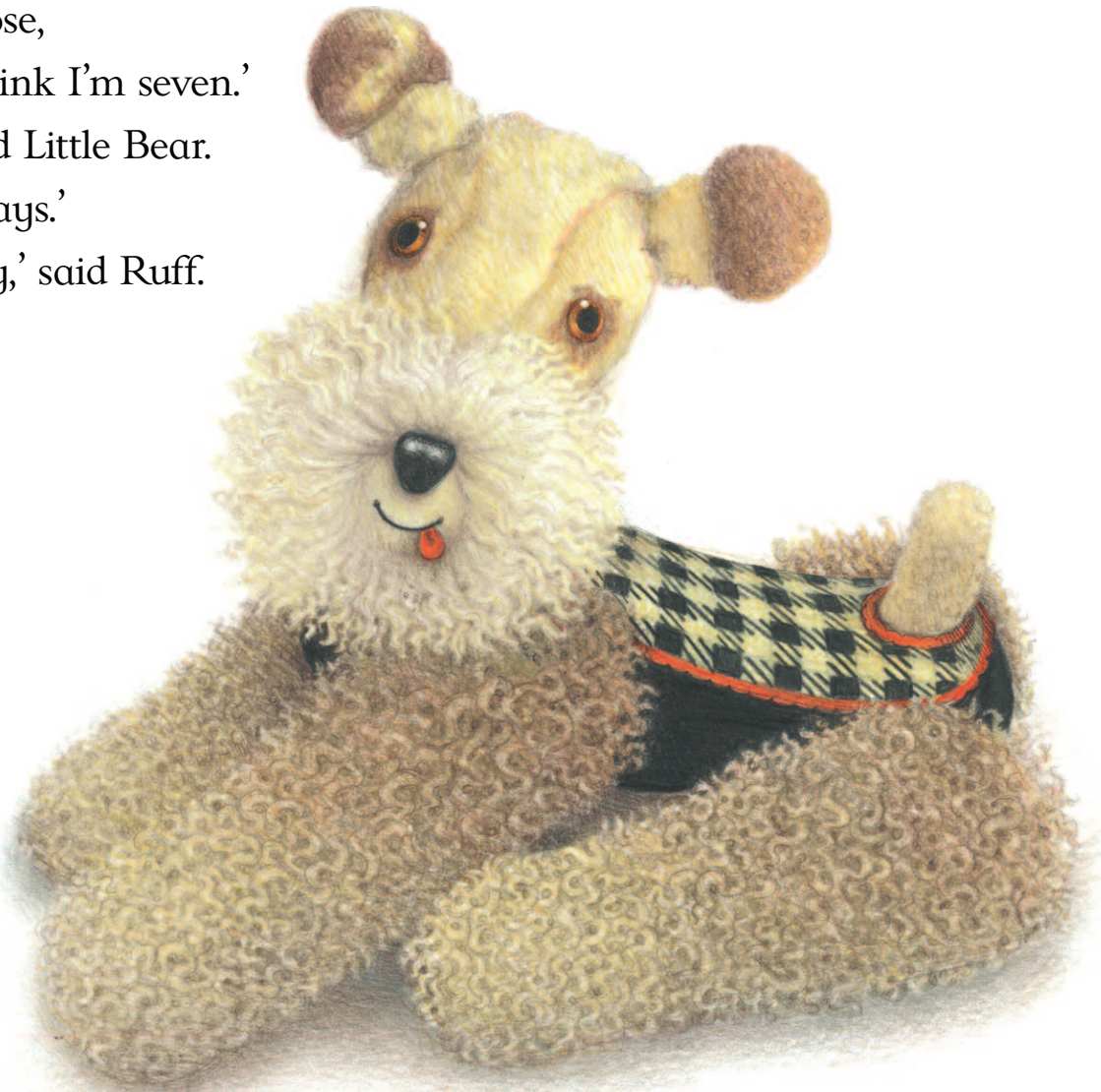
‘...five, six...’ and his nose,
