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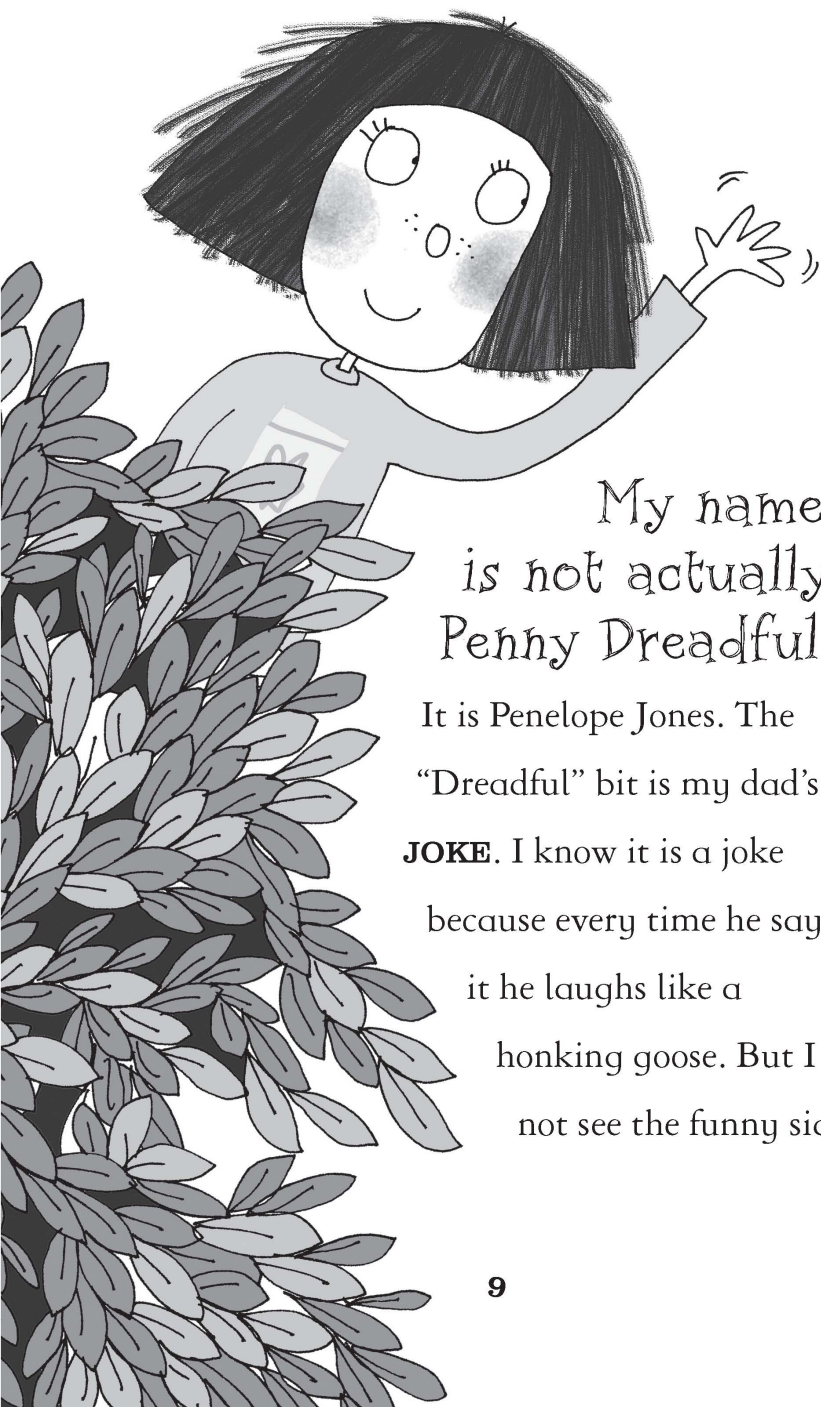

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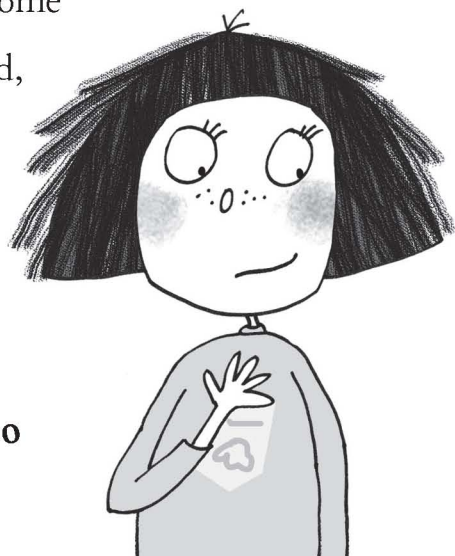




My name

a) A wasp

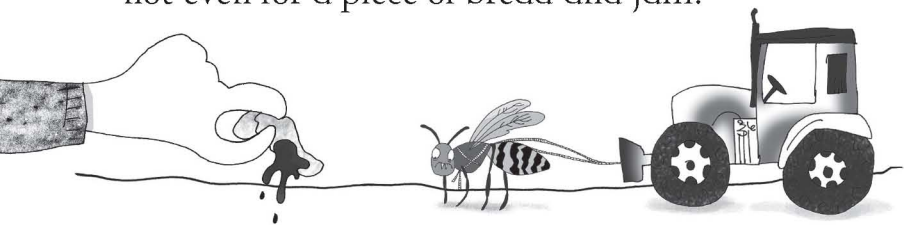
2. A factory that makes fish fingers
