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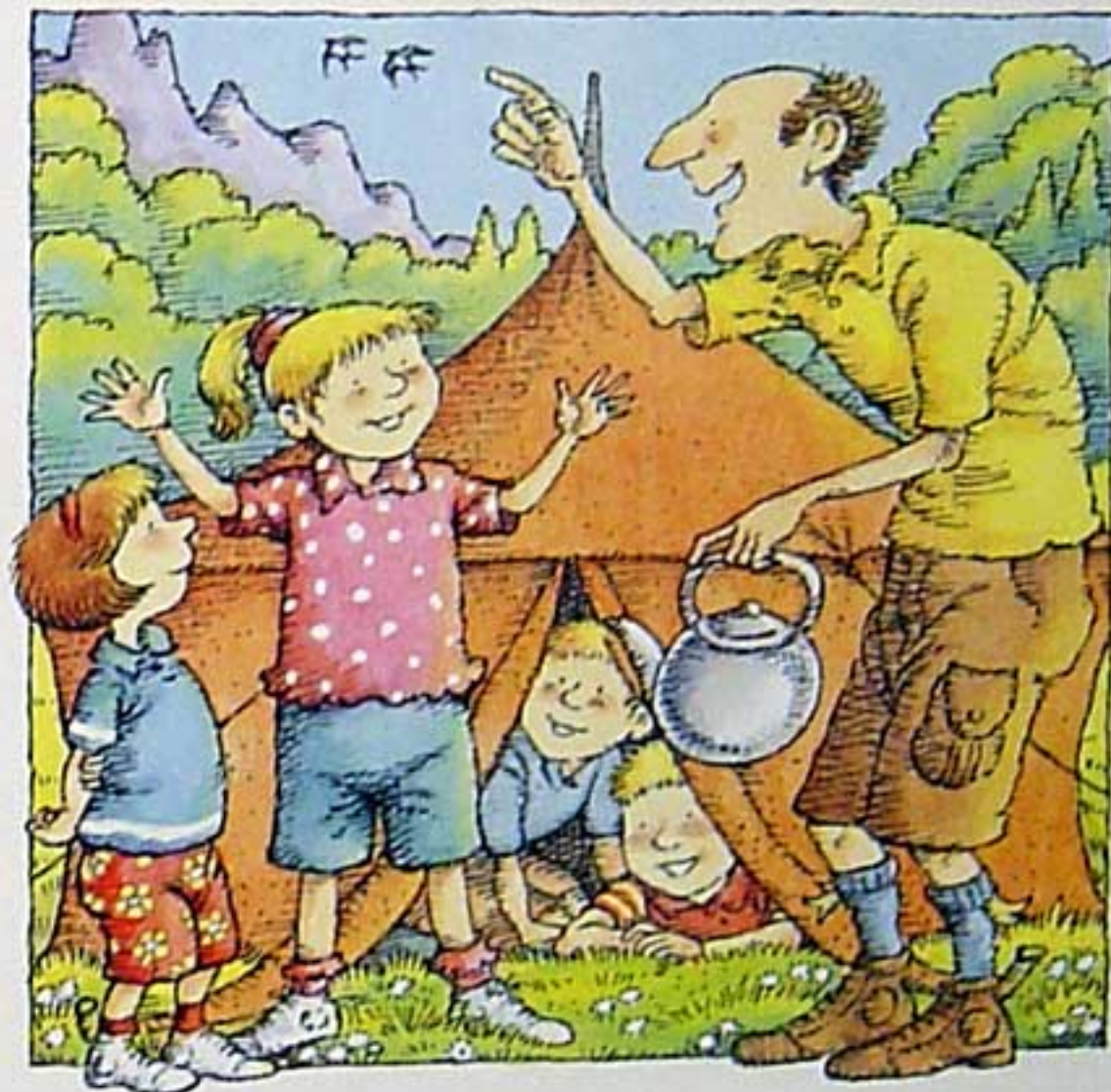
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"I'm really glad we came to Rocky Park!" said Julie. "There's pony-trekking! And caving! And rock climbing!"
